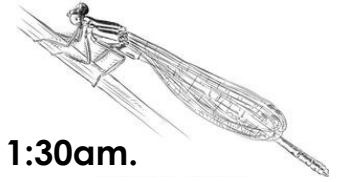




## Knee-high Naturalist Program at Richard Bong State Recreation Area
